INSURANCE

Within the joint Squash/Tennis insurance policy, the Club has insured the Control room, Ball room and meets our percentage of the facilities we use in the Squash building, plus Public liability cover under our joint policy.

Because of the increase in cover and the level of excess , your committee has decided not to insure the Stand, garage or courts. The minimum excess of \$1000 means we would not claim for nets or lawn mower plus the excess for other structures is 10% of the indemnity value.

With these details before us the committee decided to fund our own insurance by investing \$3000 per year, similar to the funding of \$12000 per year we currently self fund for court replacement.
