* 10am – noon * Ball Machine * Grasshoppers equipment * games * coaches *

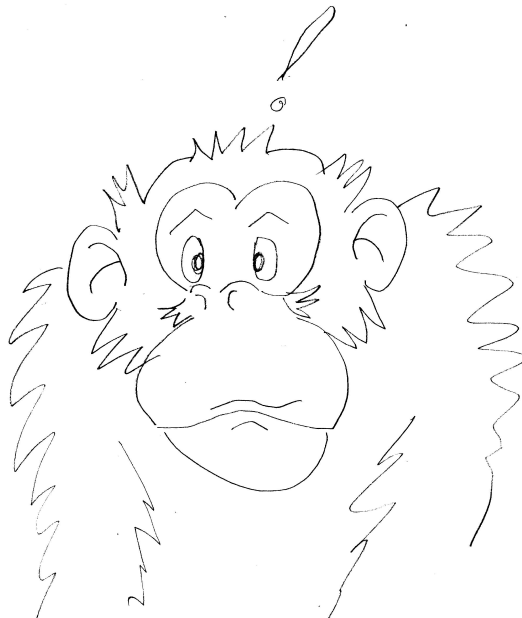
Come down and find out what we have to offer for the upcoming season.
